



Guidelines for Country/Town Profile

Technical details (for more information, please refer to comprehensive guidelines on : www.uitp.org/pti)

Length : maximum 10,000 characters with spaces

Illustration : original photographs (to be scanned by UITP) or high resolution digital photographs (300 DPI), diagrams or graphs to be delivered in their original format (as separate files, excell, powerpoint).

Content :

- Short general introduction of the country/town (number of inhabitants, area, average income/inhab., etc...)
- Short introduction of current and planned public transport networks: modes of transport (rail, bus, etc...), length, ridership, capacity, information and ticketing systems, services, special services, etc...)
- PT organisation (between authorities and operators, between the different levels of administration, etc...)
- PT financing and funding, role of the private sector
- Current and future stakes, planned developments and or changes
- Perspectives
- Any other feature specific to the country/town
- Articles should be factual (with updated figures)
- UITP will publish a map of countries with the major towns mentioned in the article. However, any additional map or any map of town or network would be welcome (as a separate high resolution scan).
