A new automatic metro line project in Lausanne



The Council of State of Vaud (Switzerland) is evaluating the budget request for the first construction phase of automated metro network development program at Lausanne. The mostly crowded section «Gare-Flon» of existing m2 line, operated without driver since 2008, will thus benefit of systems revamping and the addition of a new m3 driverless line in a separate parallel tunnel. Overall program will afterwards include m3 extension to north quarters «Blécherette», m2 trackwork optimisation to reach 90' headway in the long term, and building of necessary maintenance and operation facilities.
